Christian Caring: Understanding Pastoral Care (AN IN PERSON ONLY SEMINAR)

Objective

By the end of the morning session, participants will:

- understand the scope of pastoral care and be familiar with major definitions
- evaluate strengths and weaknesses of 2 or 3 models of pastoral care
- understand pastoral care within a web of relationships

By the end of the afternoon session participants will be able to:

- understand the importance of empathy and the primacy of listening in pastoral care
- consider the diverse theological, cultural, and personal backgrounds parishioners and other care seekers bring; offer supportive care through the co-creation of meaning.
- make intentional use of first, second, and third-order language to address theological and pastoral concerns.
- identify life-limiting models of communication and move towards life-giving practices.

Format: This whole day workshop will include a mix of presentation, group work, discussion and role play exercises.

The workshop will be offered in person only. The material will be presented in English; participants are welcome to ask questions and respond in either English or French. If numbers permit, small group work will be done in either English or French. Handouts will be in English.

Required reading: On registration you will be sent pre-reading by email.

Copies of works cited and suggested resources for further reading will be provided during the session.
